



Note: Allah did not refer to "People of the Abrogated Scriptures" or "People of the Corrupted Scriptures" or "People of the Ascended Scriptures" as Christian Scriptures were considered true and divine during the prophet's time.

8. The Qur'an exhorted the prophet of Islam to test the truthfulness of his message against previous divine revelation.

"If you went in doubt as to what We have revealed unto thee, then ask those who have been reading the Book from before thee: the Truth hath indeed come to thee from thy Lord: so be in no wise of those in doubt:." (Surah 10:94)

فَإِنْ كُنْتُمْ فِي شَكٍّ مِمَّا أَنْزَلْنَا عَلَيْكَ مِنَ الْكِتَابِ مِنْ قَبْلِكَ فَطَلِّمْ عَلَيْهِ السَّلَامَ فَيَأْتِيكَ بِهِ سَلَامٌ. (سورة 10: 94)

Note: The Qur'an demands Mohammed take the writings of Jews and Christians as a model, and when in doubt, he is to seek guidance in them. Surely, Allah would not advise his messenger to seek understanding from the People of the Book if their Scripture was corrupt.

9. The Qur'an insists that God's revelation and words will never change.

"...there is none that can alter the words (and decrees) of Allah" (Surah 6:34). "... no change can there be in the words of Allah. This is indeed the supreme felicity" (Surah 10:64).

... وَلَا يَسْبِغُ لِكَلِمَاتِ اللَّهِ... (سورة 6: 34)  
لَا يَتَّبِعُ لِكَلِمَاتِ اللَّهِ ذَلِكَ هُوَ الْفَوْزُ الْعَظِيمُ. (سور 10: 64)

Note: Claiming God's Word is corrupted is a severe insult to God, implying He could not keep His Word from forgery.

10. The Qur'an declares that the Bible contains commands from God which are the foundation of sound decision; whoever disbelieves the Bible has lost his way.

"But why do they come to thee for decision, when they have (their own) law before them? — therein is the (plain) command of Allah; yet even after that, they would turn away..." (Surah 5:43).

وَكَيْفَ يُحْكُمُ لَكُمْ وَعِنْدَهُمُ الْقُرْآنُ الَّذِي فِيهِ أَمْرُ اللَّهِ ثُمَّ يَنْتَهُونَ مِنْ بَعْدِ ذَلِكَ وَمَا أُولَئِكَ بِالْمُؤْمِنِينَ. (سورة 5: 43)

## My Muslim Friend

Because the Bible is a book from God containing a universal message to mankind, its great truths must not be disregarded. The Bible's truths include the following:

### We all have sinned.

"For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God." (Romans 3:23).

Note: The word "sin" means "to miss the mark." We have all, at some time, deliberately chosen to disobey God.

### Sin brings a penalty.

"For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." (Romans 6:23).

Note: A "wage" is a payment for service. The payment for our sin is death, which is an eternal separation from God in a place called "hell."

### Jesus paid the penalty.

"But God commendeth His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." (Romans 5:8).

Note: God proved His love for us by sending Christ to die on the cross for our sins.

### Salvation is yours if you believe.

"That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved." (Romans 10:9).

Note: Salvation is free if you repent of your sins and believe that Christ died for your sins on the cross and rose again on the third day. Your sins can be forgiven if you express your belief in Jesus.
